



Announcement of Phuket Province

Title : Intention of Honesty in Public Administration

According to a Cabinet Resolution dated 23 January, 2018, it is agreed that government organizations will participate in an Integrity and Transparency Assessment – ITA, to be used as a guideline and mechanism to prevent and suppress corruption according to the policies of the National Anti-Corruption Commission, and phase 3 of the National Strategy. This resolution has been enacted in order to improve moral assessment and transparency of government organizations to ensure that the development of a system of anti-corruption is used in the assessment of honorable behavior and transparency of government bureaus. The government administrators will have a major role in supporting and ensuring that government bureaus perform their duties honorably, transparently and honestly.

Phuket province promulgates the policy of honor and transparency in government administration and sets standard guidelines for government officials as follows:

1. Public Administration staff will carry out their duties with good governance responding to the needs of the citizens in a rapid, correct, equal, transparent and fair manner. Pertinent information is to be revealed to the public or stakeholders.

2. Create core values and attitudes of virtue in government officials so they may be tolerant, forbearing, and make sacrifices during government services. Instill and communicate the values and virtues within the organization so as to perform their duties to the benefit of the Administration, and have the courage to accept responsibility for any mistakes made.

3. Encourage transparency in all government procurement processes, and provide the opportunity for the public to share their opinion towards the processes. Ensure validation of the process to prevent policy corruption which could lead to a specific entity in the private sector gaining benefits or requesting benefits, money or properties.

4. Publicize channels through which the public is able to notify the authorities regarding information on corruption.

5. Set up any measures for preventing and suppressing corruption and dereliction of duties in government sectors.
