**Title: Seeking the tourists' collaboration during the crisis to curb the spread of the
Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)**

Following the continuous spread of the Coronavirus (COVID - 19) both in Thailand and abroad, the World Health Organization (WHO) has announced the COVID - 19 outbreak as a pandemic and requested all countries to urgently increase proactive measures to combat COVID - 19. It is evidenced that the disease transmission is yet on the raise, which affect the safety and security of the peoples' living. As a result, the Committee of Communicable Disease of Phuket Province has intensified the measures, in accordance with the guideline set by the Thai cabinet meeting on March 17, 2020, to curb the spread of the COVID - 19 in the area of Phuket Province, for instance, three previous issued Phuket Announcements by the Governor of Phuket Province.

In order to raise the standard of prevention and effectively control of the spread of the disease in Phuket Province, the Governor of Phuket Province, with the decision of the Committee of Communicable Disease of Phuket on Wednesday March 25, 2020, has kindly asked and sought the tourists' collaboration, both Thai and international, to remain inside their residence (all accommodations) from 17.00 hrs. to 24.00 hrs. of March 25, 2020.
