



Phuket Announcement

Title : Suggested Measures for Owners or Residents of Houses, Housing , Places , or Vehicles which could pose a high risk of communicable disease or disease outbreak , or suspected communicable disease or disease outbreak in Phuket province

In order to prevent and curb the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) according to section 95 of Communicable Disease Act of B.E.2558 (2015) together with the decision of Committee of Communicable Disease of Phuket Province meeting section 10/2020 dated on March 28, 2020 , according to conditions no. 7 and 11 by section 9 of Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation, B.E. 2548 (2005) (version 1) and Thailand Emergency Situation Act of B.E. 2548 (2505) dated on March 25, 2563 (2020)

Phuket Province would like to request that owners or residents of houses, housing , places , or vehicles which are at a high risk of spreading or being in contact with this communicable disease or disease outbreak , in Phuket province carry out measures to eliminate or destroy chances of further spread of the infection or communicable disease including improving sanitation systems to ensure they are in good condition in order to prevent and curb the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) according to the measures set by the Government as follows:

- 1.To clean all surfaces or floors of places with which you may contact before carrying out any activities and eliminate any waste every day.
2. To ask owners, employees, participants, and concerned persons to wear face masks and wash their hand with soap or alcohol gel or disinfectant, and also prepare alcohol gel or disinfectant, for persons who come to obtain a service. Furthermore, please arrange seating or standing so that each person is at least 1 meter apart to prevent the spread of disease by saliva droplets.
3. To control the numbers to avoid crowding and restrict the time spent is the activity to avoid direct contact between participants.

Penalties for any persons who violate or fail to comply with this announcement according to section 52 of the Communicable Disease Act of B.E. 2558 range from less than one (1) year in prison or a fine of up to 100,000 baht or both.

Effective from March 28, 2020 until otherwise announced or cancelation.
